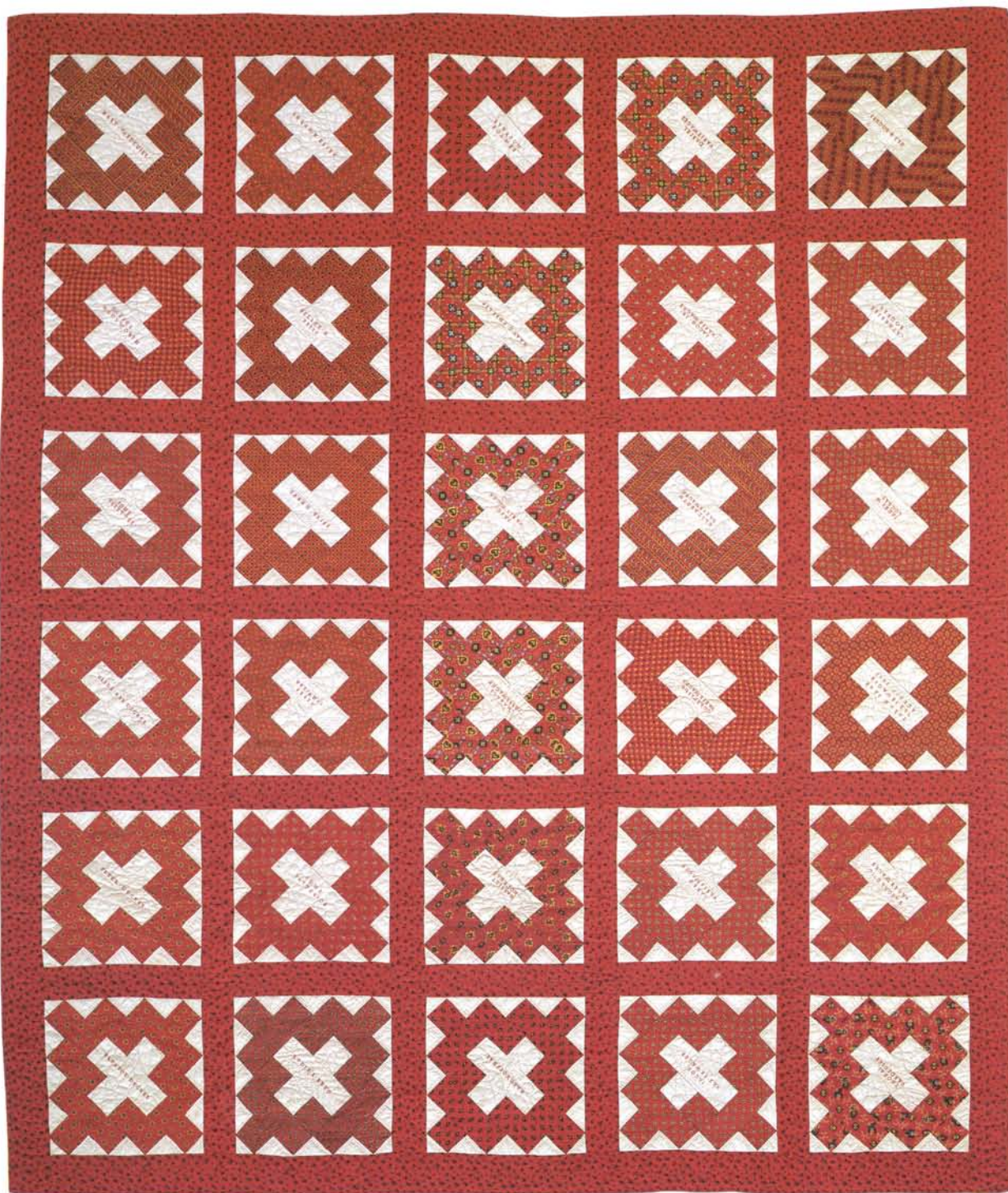

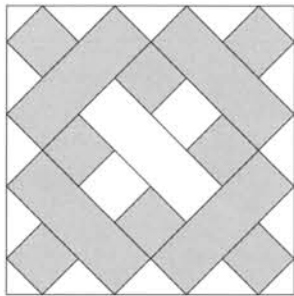
12" block, straight set with sashing

<i>Finished size</i>	47" x 61"	75" x 90"	89" x 90"	104" x 104"
Blocks set	3 x 4	5 x 6	6 x 6	7 x 7
Total blocks	12	30	36	49

## YARDAGE

Light-colored background	1¼	2½	3¾	4¼
Reds (pieced blocks)	1¼	2¾	3¼	4¾
Red (sashing, border, and binding)	1¾	2¾	2¾	3
Backing	2¾	5¾	8	9

## CUTTING

### TRADITIONAL:

Use template patterns 1g, 3j, 5h, and 9d.

### QUICK:

Light-colored background:

2½"-wide strips 2 4 5 7

6¾"-wide strips 1 2 3 4

Cut strips to 2½" x 6¾" pieces.

4½"-wide strips 4 10 12 17

Cut strips to 4½" squares.

Then cut squares into quarters diagonally.

2¾"-wide strips 2 4 5 6

Cut strips to 2¾" squares.

Then cut the squares in half diagonally.

Reds (pieced blocks):

2¾"-wide strips 6 15 18 25

6¾"-wide strips 3 8 9 13

Cut strips to 2¾" x 6¾" pieces.

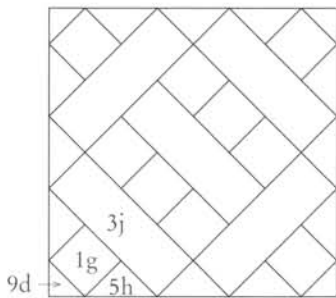
### SASHING, BORDER, AND BACKING:

Sashing: width 2¾" 2¾" 2¾" 2¾"

Border: width 3½" 3½" 3½" 3½"

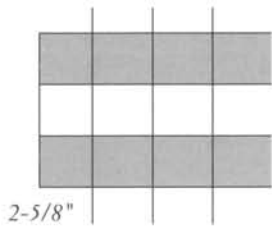
Backing: lengths 2 2 3 3

See piecing diagram B A C C



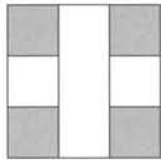

## CONSTRUCTION

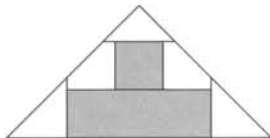

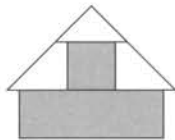

Make one for each block.

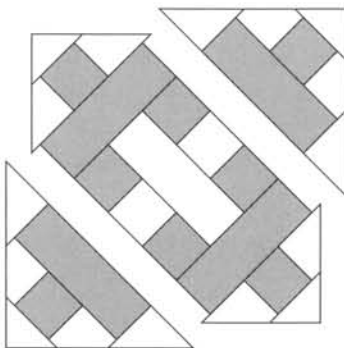


Make two for each block.

The signatures on the sample quilt were done in cross stitch. You could also use a fine-line permanent pen.

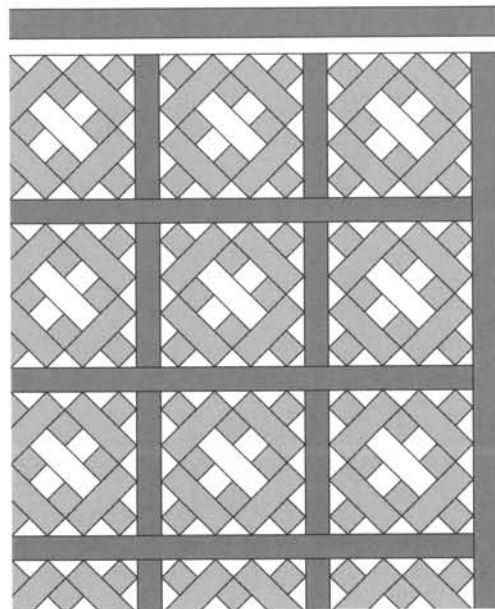
1. Sew red and light-colored background strips together in sets. Then cut them apart every 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " , as shown. Make enough sets for the total blocks needed. **HELPFUL HINT:** Each set makes eight blocks.

2. Cut the remaining 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ "-wide red strips to 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " squares.

3. Unit construction: see diagrams.  
4. Block construction: see diagram. Side and corner triangles are cut too large. Trim the blocks to measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

5. Lay out all the blocks. Sew the pieced blocks and sashing strips in a straight set. Refer to Chapter 5 for specific instructions.

6. Attach the border to complete the quilt top.
