BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

NOTE: For detailed paper foundation-piecing instructions, consult books by Carol Doak or the DVD, Carol Doak Teaches You to Paper Piece—available from C&T Publishing.

1. Make a copy of the block foundation.*
2. Cut the following pieces, and label them with the location number(s).

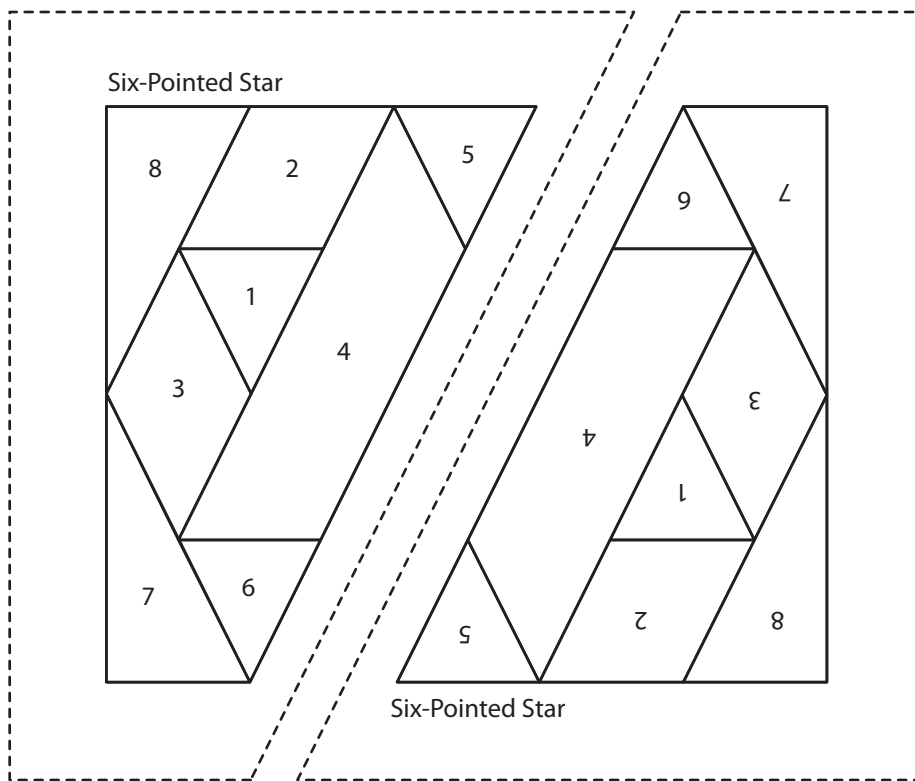
Fabric	Number to cut	Size to cut	Location number
Yellow	4	1½" x 3"	7, 8
White	8	1½" x 2"	2, 3, 5, 6
Blue	2	1½" x 1½"	1
	2	1¼" x 3½"	4

3. Foundation paper piece the block. (There will be overlap all around).
4. Trim the completed block, leaving a ½" margin outside the finished block on all sides. Do not remove the foundation paper.

* Carol Doak's Foundation Paper (available from C&T Publishing) is suggested.

Block foundation (reversed for piecing fabric) • Finished size: 3" x 3"

* CARD ASSEMBLY

- These cards can be oriented either vertically or horizontally.

- Center your block in the 3" x 3" opening.

HINT: For correct orientation, position the block and view it from the front before adhering it.

- To adhere the block edges to the card, remove the paper from the 2 adhesive strips. Add extra adhesive tabs as needed. Fold the inside flap over the back of the block, and press on it firmly to seal.

- For an extra special touch, embellish your card by stitching on the paper with decorative thread—either by hand or by machine.
